STAINED GLASS

Following my inspection on Sunday 26th July of the stained glass damaged by vandals, I have pleasure in forwarding this short report.

The Trust will be pleased to carry out the necessary repairs which are located as follows:-

- 1) West Window: 5 damaged quarries of tinted and plain glass.
- 2) 2nd Window from South in West Wall: Damage to the foot of the figure of Moses.

The repairs can be carried out 'in situ' using appropriately toned glass and I will be prepared to carry out the work as quickly as possible on receiving the necessary authorisation.
