Display of Medieval Stained Glass
found in March 1990 inside alabaster chest tomb
in the Savile Chapel
containing effigies of a Knight and his Lady.

All the 17 pieces of glass discovered within the monument are c15th in date and in remarkably fine condition. The pieces of glass are of similar date to the c15th glass in the two easternmost windows of the North Wall of the Savile Chapel.

Specialised cleaning of the glass has been undertaken by the York Glaziers' Trust which has revealed much of the painted detail of the medieval glass.

Collectively the pieces are a significant and most important 'find' and every care should be taken to ensure their preservation for future generations.
